Maths

We will consolidate our learning and read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words. We will also:

- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line
- Count in multiples of twos, fives and tens
- Recognise and name common 2-D and 3-D shapes
- Measure and begin to record capacity / volume
- Compare, describe and solve practical problems for capacity and volume
- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20
