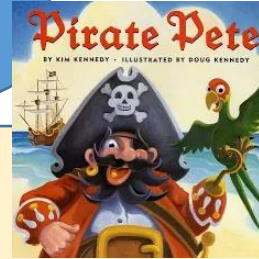


Phonics
