Phonics

We follow the Read Write Inc phonics scheme and order of sounds.

Art & Design

We will be looking at how to keep our bodies healthy.

Science

Animals including humans: We will identify and name a variety of common animals that are categorised as birds, fish, amphibians, reptiles and mammals. We will explore which animals are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will learn to describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals.

English

Our first text will be Snail and the Whale and we will be using exclamation marks to make our writing even more exciting for our readers. We will then become whale experts and will write a report full of facts! We will also write questions and answers about some very special visitors who we will be looking after...

We will look for signs of animals and birds. We will identify common animals and birds that we see. We will also look for signs of Spring as part of our learning about seasons and weather.

We will use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. We will continue to improve mouse skills and we will have opportunities to create digital imagery.
